**STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT AND GUIDELINES**

1. Testimony.  
The first thing we need to remember is we are representing God and Barton Church.
2. Respect of Authority  
Youth will respect the authority of each adult involved in the Youth Ministry. In the event that this respect is not given, parents will be immediately informed.
3. Dress Code.  
Appropriate clothing should be worn at all Youth Events. There should be no bare midriffs, no spaghetti straps, no double meaning language on shirts or other inappropriate items of clothing. Swimwear must be modest. If a student is dressed immodestly, they may be required to wear a cover up at the Youth Staff discretion.
4. Show of Affection.  
There shall be NO public displays of affection (pda). Good judgment should be used by ALL youth attending Youth Events.
5. Driving.  
No teen drivers are allowed to drive vehicles at youth sponsored events.
6. Emergency Contact Form.  
Emergency Contact forms must be completed by all students attending any Youth Event and/or meeting. This will include all emergency contact information, parent phone numbers, address, medical information, etc. Forms will be available at the Church office.
7. Permission Slips.  
Permission slips from a parent will be needed for any event involving taking a youth in or on a vehicle. This could include going in a car, riding on a hayride, if an ATV was going to be available to ride at a youth event, etc. No youth will be allowed to go in or on a vehicle without the permission slip from a parent/guardian.
8. Drugs, alcohol, tobacco.  
No drugs, alcohol, tobacco of any kind or weapons of any kind, including look-a-likes of any of these things will be allowed at any youth event.
9. Music.  
All music and media will be subject to the approval of the Youth Staff.
10. Breaking The Rules.  
If student has to be sent home for breaking the rules, it will be the parent or legal guardian's responsibility to arrange transportation.
